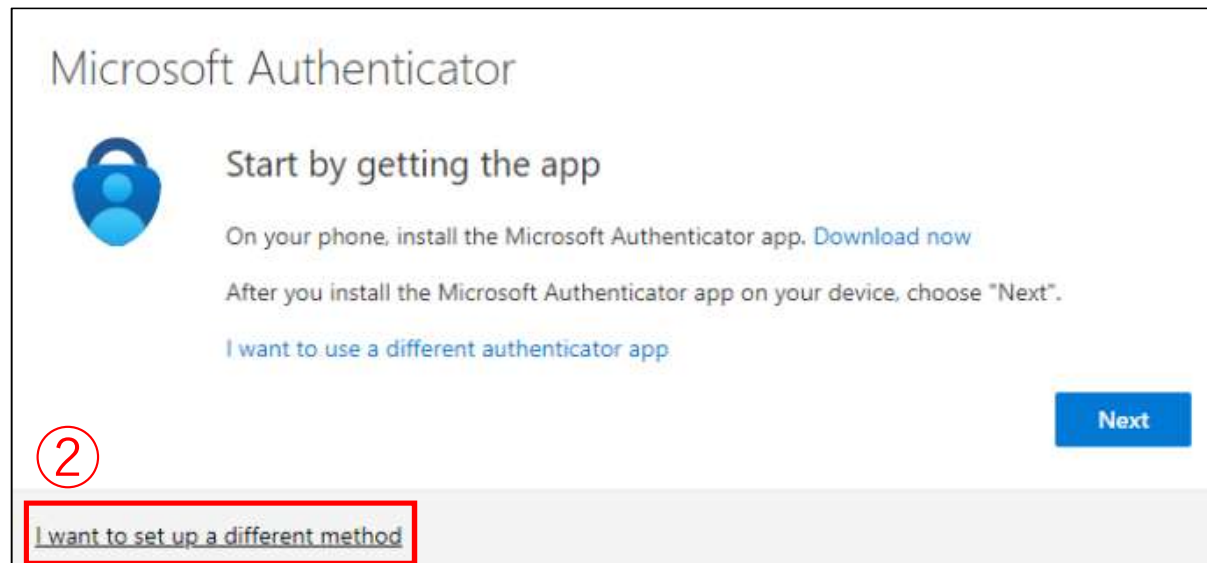
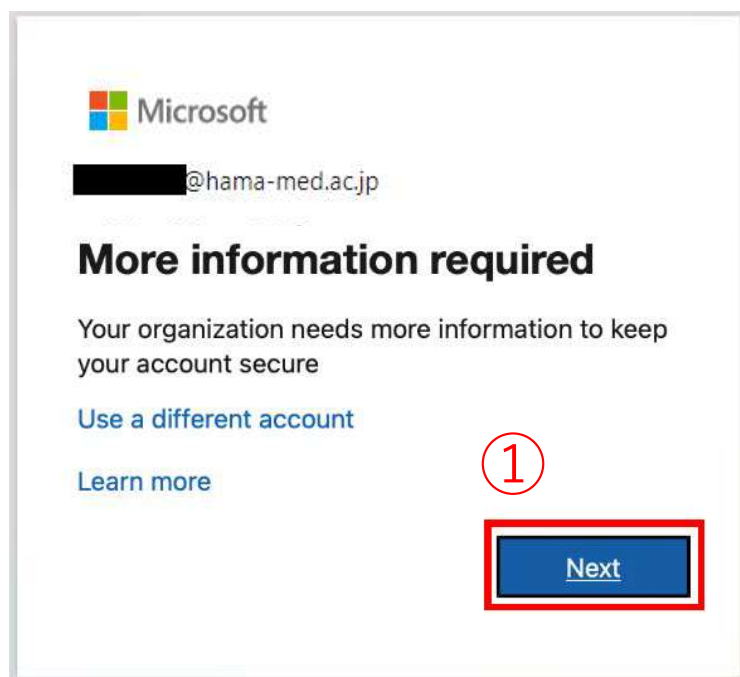
Situations where authentication is required

- When signing in for **the first time**
- **When signing in from a new device for the first time**
- When signing in **after signing out** from Microsoft365
- When using email software
- When you have not signed in for more than 90 days
- **When signing in from different browsers** (e.g. newly signed in using Firefox instead of Edge you have been using)
- ✘ Authentication will not be required every time if you didn't sign out.

Initial authentication method – mobile phone 1/3

When signing in, “**More information required**” will be displayed.

- ① Select “**Next**” and “**Start by getting the app**” window will be displayed.
- ② Select “**I want to set up a different method**”.



Initial authentication method – mobile phone 2/3


- Select "phone" from the drop-down list and Select "**Confirm**".
- Enter your mobile number and select "**Text me a code**".
- Select "**Next**".

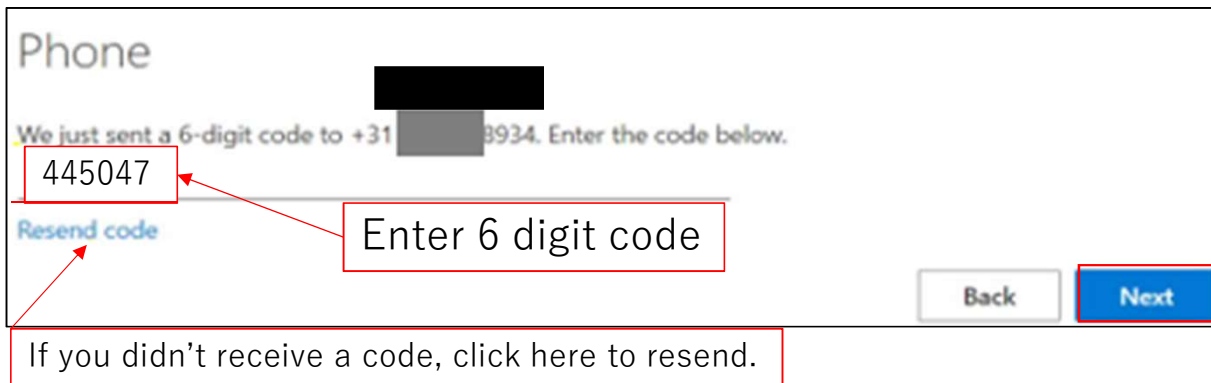

Initial authentication method – mobile phone 3/3

- A text message with a code will be sent to your mobile phone.
- Enter the code and then select “**Next**”.
