Additional Information about Our Measures Against Novel Coronavirus Infection

There has been report all around the world about the infection of Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) originated from Wuhan City of Hubei Province, China. Currently, COVID-19 is spreading all over the world such as South Korea, Italy, Iran, and other countries. Even in Japan, COVID-19 is epidemic centering on Hokkaido prefecture. We made announcement on "Our Measures Against Novel Coronavirus Infection" on Feb. 21, 2020.

Since infection of Novel Coronavirus is spreading within the country, Japan's Ministry of Health, Labor, and Welfare has <u>published consultation and medical examination guidelines for the COVID-19 coronavirus described as below #1.</u> If you apply to #1, please call Hamamatsu Public Healthcare Center <u>"returnee/close contact consultation center" TEL 053-453-6118</u> and follow their advice. Also please report to the University Health Administration Center and Student Affair Division (if you are a student) or Personnel Division via your department (if you are a faculty or employee) and explain your situation. If you have returned from epidemic areas or have had close contact with person from epidemic areas, but has no symptoms, please follow the <u>Flow Chart attached (revised 3.5.2020).</u>

## #1 Consultation Guidelines

If you have any of the following symptoms, please consult with the consultation center TEL 053-453-6118 for people with potential exposure to COVID-19:

- You have had cold symptoms or a fever of 37.5°C or over for four days or more (including when you need to continue to take an antipyretic).
- You have a strong feeling of weariness (fatigue) or shortness of breath (difficulty breathing).

## #2 Caution

- If you have a symptom of cold or a fever of over 37.5°C, please take absent leaves from work or classes or club activities. Please refrain from going out or attending events. Please wear a mask and wash your hands to avoid spreading the infection. Monitor your body temperature daily and keep record.
  - \* If you have a fever over 38.5°C or severe ill condition <u>suggesting Influenza infection</u>, call and visit the medical agency or clinic within two days.

(Useful information to prevent viral spread)

- At this time, the infection seems to spread mainly by contagion (hand, nose) and droplet (cough, sneeze). Please wash your hand with soap and running water often.
  Adding alcohol disinfection is also effective. To avoid spreading the infection to other people, wear a surgical face mask.
