◆ Restrictions

- Be mindful of others, keep quiet while others are worshipping
- Eating is not allowed (Drinking is allowed except alcohol)



◆ After use

- Put all facilities back to their original places
- Lock all the windows
- Turn off all the lights and AC
- Take your trash with you
- Make sure you are not leaving anything behind in the rooms



◆ Other

- In case of a breach of the rules, we may restrict the violator from using the room for a certain period of time.
- In case of damaging or staining rooms or facilities, the violator may be charged for the repair expenses.
